**SAT Prep Class**

This class is to help students prepare to take the SAT on October 10, 2009. It is open first to Seniors and Juniors. The class takes place on 4 consecutive Saturdays: September 12, 19, 26, and October 3rd, from 8:30 am-12:40pm. Half of the time is spent in Math review and the other in English and Writing review. The cost of the class is \$80 (check made to CCHS) and the book is included.
